HELPFUL TOOLS TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM PROPERTY FRAUD

Although rare, property fraud has been rising annually across the United States. Property/Title fraud occurs when criminals forge documents to transfer a property's title into their name, allowing them to use it as loan collateral or even sell it. Victims often face years of financial and legal challenges to reclaim ownership. While these schemes require several steps to succeed, there are ways you can protect your property—and your peace of mind.



WAYS TO PROTECT YOUR PROPERTY

- **Register with a Property Fraud Protection service.** Hartland Township residents can register for a FREE Property Fraud Protection notification service

provided through Livingston County. This service will notify you by email, text or phone call when any documents are recorded for your property. You can register for free here:

- **Check online resources.** There are many public accessible websites that can help you verify that your property is still in your name.

www.hartlandtwp.com – Review the information provided by the Tax & Assessing options on the Hartland Township page. Verify that your ownership and mailing addresses are correct.

livingstonlive.livgov.com/Deeds/ – Search for your property to see if there have been any deeds or mortgages filed for your property without your knowledge.

- **Check your credit report.** Its always a good idea to check your credit annually to make sure that any additional credit has not been secured in your name.

The best protection against property fraud is being proactive!
