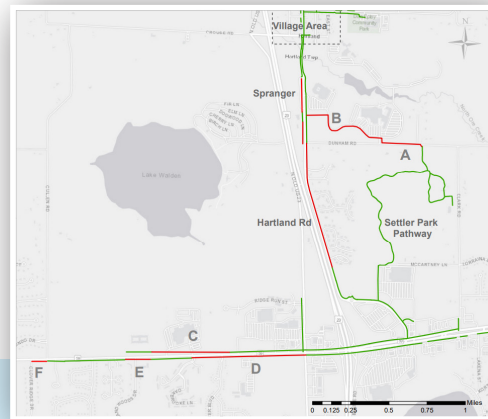
CONNECTIVITY IN HARTLAND

Improving our Community's Walkability

Over the past few years, the Hartland Board of Trustees has implemented a strategic walkability plan, adding not only to the number of sidewalks available in our community, but also increasing connectivity between key locations. The Village of Hartland has added sidewalks to connect local businesses, schools, and the library. In the spring of 2018, the sidewalk along the southern corridor of Hartland Road opened to provide connectivity between the historic heart of Hartland, businesses along M-59, and the trails at Settlers Park. A new crosswalk at Dunham Road is currently being constructed and when complete, will connect Settlers Park to a future pathway at the schools.
