A. SITE PLAN REVIEW #509

OWNER/APPLICANT: HARTLAND CONSOLIDATED SCHOOLS

Permit the construction of a wind generator as part of a High School project located at 3250 Dunham Road (Parcel ID: 08-16-300-005).

Present: George Waldrup – Hartland Schools

Commissioner Hopkins arrived at 6:05 p.m.

Director Stirling: Outlined her review letter dated August 24, 2012.

Commissioner Newsom: Asked the applicant how much power they will be getting from this unit. **Mr. Waldrup:** Stated they would be getting somewhere in the neighborhood of 3,000 watts. Its main purpose will be as an educational tool to teach students about building and servicing these units.

Commissioner Voight: Asked how the power will be stored.

Mr. Waldrup: Explained that it would be stored in a battery.

Commissioner Grissim: Asked what color of this device would be.

Director Stirling: Explained that it would most likely be a white or gray.

The Planning Commission hereby finds that due to the size of the parcel, exceeding 100 acres for the immediately adjacent properties, the existing height of the buildings in the school complex and its use as a recreational and educational facility, the height is acceptable but shall not exceed 40 feet which is consistent with the general height of the buildings.
