ROLL CALL The meeting was called to order by Chairman Fountain at 7:40 p.m. Members present: Chairman Fountain, Vice Chairman Douglass, Secretary Kalenauskas, Commissioner Colaianne and Commissioner Petrucci. Absent: Commissioner Phillips and Commissioner M. Germane. Also present: David Nicholson and Amy Neary of McKenna Associates and Deputy Zoning Administrator Lutz.
- 2. APPROVAL OF JANUARY 17, 2002 SPECIAL MEETING AGENDA -Add as item #4a. Set Public Hearing date for Beauchamps.

- 3. APPROVAL OF JANUARY 10, 2002 SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES Move to approve the January 10, 2002 Special Meeting Minutes as presented. Motion Colaianne. Second Petrucci. Voice Vote. Motion Carried. 5-0-2.

#### OLD AND NEW BUSINESS

5. DISCUSSION ON THE COMPREHENSIVE / MASTER PLAN- The revised Opportunities and Constraints map was distributed for review. This is meant as an analysis of information, not just a catalog. There will not be a soils limitations map.

The purpose of the group discussions are to formulate topics for the visioning workshops. Commissioner Kalenauskas, Commissioner Colaianne and Mr. Nicholson broke into a smaller group to discuss their topic of Land Use and Density.

Chairman Fountain, Commissioner Douglass and Chairman Fountain remained to discuss transportation and pedestrian access. Chairman Fountain summarized the activities of the Road Committee. Their recommendations included: chloriding of all gravel roads in the Township, paved aprons at Fenton and Clyde and Fenton and Dunham, use limestone instead of gravel and the limestone trial on Clark Road. There were matching dollars with the County. The paving of Bergin is again under discussion. The paving of Hacker was recommended but abandoned.

Paving should be done to benefit the residents, not those traversing the Township.

The Township must plan where the density will be and create the infrastructure to support it. Paving brings development. Water and sewer brings residential development.

More north – south routes would take some the pressure off the M59 / US23 interchange. There is a very limited number of east – west crossing points over US 23. This tends to funnel traffic through the M59 – US23 interchange.

An update on the status of the trail system / greenway area from the Parks and Recreation Committee would be helpful.

It is difficult to connect the east and west areas of the Township by sidewalks or trails because of the need to cross US23.

At 9:00 p.m. the two groups rejoined for discussion.
